

IMPORTANT COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE FROM CMHD

DUE FOR 2ND DOSE OF VACCINE: (BRING YOUR VACCINE CARD)

If you received a COVID-19 vaccine from CMHD @ Miller Ridge Elem. on 2/27/21 and are due for your 2nd dose, you should have or will be receiving a phone call to schedule an appointment for the clinic on Saturday 3/27/21. Please check your voicemail for a call back number if you do not answer unknown calls. If you do not receive a call, and are due for your 2nd vaccine, please come to the Middletown High School (NEW LOCATION) from 10a-1p on Saturday 3/27/21.

If you received your 1st dose on 3/4 or 3/5 in Council Chambers you are due for your 2nd dose on 4/1/21 at the same location. You should also be receiving a call as mentioned above. If you do not receive a call, please return to Council Chambers on 4/1 at your previous appointment time, between 9a-3p.

If you received your 1st dose on 3/13 @ Miller Ridge Elem. you are due for your 2nd dose on 4/11/21 at Middletown High School. You will now be receiving a call to schedule an appointment. This is different information than what was provided previously. Please respond to the call to be placed on the schedule. If you do not receive a call, please come to Middletown High School between 10a-12p.

We are committed to providing the 2nd vaccination to each person we have previously vaccinated.

PRE-REGISTRATION UPDATE:

Gov. DeWine has mandated new COVID-19 vaccine providers to participate in the use of a central scheduling tool developed with the Ohio Department of Health. We have closed our website to new registrations and will be used to provide information clinics and provide the link to the new system for scheduling.

We have provided the State's call center with a list of those who were registered on our website prior to 3/17.

- They have been calling to schedule appointments for our clinic on 3/27. This could be a "robo-call" from an out of town phone number.
- They will leave a voicemail with a number to call if you do not answer unknown calls.
- Please call them to schedule, if still interested.
- The call center will attempt to contact individuals on the list 3 times. If you do not return the call to schedule, it is assumed you are no longer interested in receiving a vaccine from CMHD and there will be no further contact.

We appreciate your patience and grace as we move forward with Gov. DeWine's request to use this new system. Once the call center has attempted to contact all on our provided lists, we will be going "LIVE" on the Get The Shot Ohio website with available clinic dates, locations and appointment times available for you to schedule online.
