HEALTH ORDERS AND ESTABLISHING
SOCIAL DISTANCING AND FACIAL
COVERING POLICY TO CONFORM WITH
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH ORDERS
AND CDC GUIDELINES

The undersigned makes the following findings of fact:

1. On May 12, 2021, Ohio Governor DeWine announced that the vast majority of health orders will be rescinded on June 2, 2021 at 12:01 a.m. EDT;
2. On May 17, 2021, Stephanie McCloud, in her capacity as the Ohio Director of Health, in response to new guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"), issued a *Second Amended Order for Social Distancing, Facial Coverings and Non-Congregating*, effective until June 2, 2021 at 12:01 a.m.; and
3. Based upon the Director's *Second Amended Order*, the protocols set forth in this Court's Entry and Order dated May 8, 2020 and effective May 8, 2020 are no longer necessary to protect the health of court employees and the public.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED:

This Court's *Order*, dated May 8, 2020 and effective May 8, 2020, as well as any prior orders extended by the May 8, 2020 *Order* are hereby rescinded and shall expire June 2, 2021 at 12:01 a.m.

The Court reserves the right to modify this Order, as necessary, for the safe and orderly conduct of any and all court proceedings. Specific instructions regarding any such modifications will be given to the parties and counsel at such time.
